Footnotes

UNDER PROTEST set the pace in the two path, drew clear leaving the quarter pole and held under a drive while continuing on her left lead. SMART RULER lacked speed, raced along the rail, closed inside on her left lead and missed. VERO BEACH chased the pace three wide, came five wide into the lane and rallied. ELECTRIC EMILY chased the pace two wide and lacked the needed rally while continuing on her left lead in the lane. SMART FOREST pressed the pace inside of the winner down the backstretch, angled three wide near the quarter pole to prompt the pace outside of that rival around the turn and weakened on her left lead in the lane. TORI'S BREEZE failed to menace while racing four wide. CONSOLVER was rank early and quickly lost contact under a firm hold.
