Footnotes

LITTLE FEAT settled close off the rail, eased out leaving the half mile pole, started a bid at the seven sixteenths, held aim rounding the final turn and dug in under determined handling through the lane to inch ahead the final strides. BIGUM rated just off the pace about the three path, moved to the front three wide approaching the seven sixteenths pole, contested the edge toward the inside rounding the final turn and held the advantage to deep stretch before yielding; grudgingly. WEGNER rated the pace inside, was caught at the half mile pole and gave close chase down the backstretch before fading. BLUE SOLDIER stalked the pace off the rail, moved to a brief slim lead between horses past the half mile pole, gave chase through the backstretch then leveled off rounding the final turn. SARATOGA SWING rated off the early pace outside, gave chase from the half mile pole then weakened toward the final turn. STRATEGIC HOPE, off the pace and off the rail, showed no response down the backstretch. FIRSTIE dropped well back outside.
