Footnotes

STAR OVER DUBAI prompted the issue from the rail, inherited the lead when pace setter came wide into the stretch, held clear under a drive. JOE'S LAD set the pace three wide, bore out into the stretch then was second best. KILL THE JOKER five wide along the backstretch, bid three wide on the turn, finished well. CATCH DURING three wide down the backstretch, came six wide around the turn and finished strongly. LIFE ON THE RIVER four wide along the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, finished with good energy. SONG FOR NICOLE pressed the pace four wide, lacked a closing bid. BOLD GENTLEMAN well positioned three wide, lacked a late response. GONDOLIER sluggish at the start, was no factor on the rail.
