CHESS MASTER set the pace on a clear lead into the stretch, dug in when challenged and was all out to last. PATRON SAINT off a step slow, moved up four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. THE JACKAL pressed the issue from the rail, was set down for the drive, missed in a strong effort. WATCH TOWER prompted the pace three wide, finished well. SIR SILVER FOX saved ground, rallied five wide on the turn, finished strongly. EGO'S APPEAL showed early speed from the inside, steadily fell back. SOUTHERN REVIEW flashed brief foot on the rail.
