Footnotes

BLOOD MOON settled off the pace inside, rallied to the front nearing the three sixteenths pole, was quickly clear and steadily handled to maintain. UNSHATTERABLE settled back toward mid track, bid from the three eighths pole and finished well while dueling for place. CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY, unhurried off the rail, bid from the quarter pole, eased out entering the stretch and finished well to show. TUTAW, unhurried off the rail, bid inside into the final turn and finished evenly. J TRAIN rated back inside, bid at the rail leaving the quarter pole then lost ground while leveling off entering the stretch. CHANGE MY NUMBER drew clear for early position inside, was rated on the front end to the quarter pole, came under pressure beyond that point but gave way from the head of the lane. CROSSROAD'S GOLD and CRAFTY MISCHIEF were outrun. XTRA REWARD was not a factor.
