LIL MISS JANE prompted the pace from the rail, made a slim lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch under strong urging. YES OUI SI forced the issue three and four wide, finished strongly. QUICK SHOW three wide down the backstretch, bid five wide around the turn and finished well. LOUD RAVENS advanced just off the rail, closed with a rush through the stretch. FOREVER BLESSING made a slim lead along the backstretch, dug in around the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. PRIZED DESIGN stalked the leaders from the inside, lacked a closing bid. E. T. WONDER flashed early speed inside, steadily fell back. MO MO TOBIN within striking distance on the rail, failed to respond. LUXURY TAX was no factor, five wide. ANOTHER BUCKAROO off a step slow then in tight at the start, showed little on the rail.
