Footnotes

BRING IT ON SALLY rated close off the rail, challenged past the five sixteenths pole, dug in to a slim lead midway on the final turn and held on in an outward drift under determined handling. SET SAIL steadied to avoid Belle Valee on the first turn, rated off the pace inside, closed the gap from the half mile pole, was boxed on the heels of Backhanded Jane near the five sixteenths pole, resumed her efforts rounding the final turn and finished well while unable to catch the winner. BACKHANDED JANE rated a short lead inside, came under pressure leaving the five sixteenths pole, yielded to the winner midway on the final turn and dug in a close factor through the upper stretch before weakening. QUEEN NEFERTITI steadied to avoid Belle Valee on the first turn, made a bid at the half mile pole but lacked further on the final turn. HEY U was kept just off the pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths pole then weakened in the stretch. PAY NO MIND came away awkwardly and never factored. RUNAWAY VALAY was no factor after a mild middle bid. AROYALSWEET, close to the early pace off the rail, gave way after three eighths. BELLE VALEE broke down into the first turn, eased and was vanned off.
