VALENTINE SECRET set the pace along the, was collared in midstretch and held well to preserve the place. ALLEGHENY SHINE lagged inside, circled five wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. RUNAWAY TURBO went evenly inside. MR. B. H. TINKLE pressed the pace two wide and weakened around the far turn. STOP THE BULL stalked the pace three wide and lacked a closing bid. JET KWIK failed to menace while racing two and three wide. FIRST UP saved ground to no avail. TUP TAKES' T MAN chased the pace five wide, faded nearing the far turn then steadied along from the three-sixteenths pole to the wire.
