Footnotes

PINE BROOK stalked the leaders three wide, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch then was all out to last. FOR APPEAL bore out at the start, bumped with TY ODIE, moved up four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. DEMPSEY forced the pace from the rail, had aim in the stretch, came up empty. IM A TIGGER TOO pressed the issue three wide, lacked a late response. MR. ZULU exchanged bumps after the start, saved ground, finished strongly three wide. MADMAN set the pace under heavy pressure, dug in around the turn, weakened in the drive. LEVITE three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. TY ODIE exchanged bumps after the start, was five wide along the backstretch, never threatened. LOVE ME LATER bore out at the start, stopped after a half four and five wide.
