**Footnotes**

THAT'STHEQUESTION stalked the pace off the rail, moved to the lead toward the three eighths pole, contested a slight disadvantage rounding the final turn, recovered slim control in the upper stretch and dug in under a determined drive to best Sporty Boy. SPORTY BOY stalked the pace three wide, gave chase from the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead midway on the final turn, gave back the lead in the upper stretch but dug in gamely to the wire. FIRST AND BAY, five wide the first turn, chased the leaders outside through the backstretch and was gaining slowly to deep stretch. MONEY ISSUES, well back of the early pace toward mid track, made an outside bid down the backstretch and rounded the final turn five wide before leveling off. LEVITE raced well back off the rail, closed some ground through the backstretch, eased three wide rounding the final turn and improved mildly in the stretch. HIT A HOMER had a short early lead inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole and remained a close factor to the middle of the final turn before weakening. NEVER MINED saved ground from the first turn while racing well back. YELLATTHEMINISTER settled just off the early pace inside but had no response near the rail through the final turn. PLEZE MR PRESIDENT was not a factor.
