SWEETLY BOLD chased the early pace and faded. HALF A PAT lacked a rally. SHE HAS WINGS failed to menace. ILIAD'S CLASSIC broke down in the stretch, vanned off. HOT SHOT DIAMOND broke down on the far turn, vanned off.
