SO IT'S STORMIN pressed the pace just off the rail, gained a clear lead around the turn but was all out to last. MORELAND PARK set the pace under heavy pressure, steadied briefly late on the turn then missed in a game effort. NAPOLEON J bumped early on the backstretch, forced the pace on the rail, finished well. KALIK YOUR HEELS exchanged bumps with QUIET PRIVATEER at the start, stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond in the lane. TROPICAL WAVE prompted the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. TRIEDTOSELLHIM bumped with LARRUP repeatedly down the backstretch and was no factor. LARRUP bumped with TRIEDTOSELLHIM repeatedly down the backstretch, failed to menace. HE'S A ROCKET MAN had little left after a half on the rail. QUIET PRIVATEER exchanged bumps with KALIK YOUR HEELS at the start then showed little. The rider of TRIEDTOSELLHIM claimed foul against NAPOLEON J alleging interference shortly after the start. The rider of MORELAND PARK claimed foul against the winner alleging interference late on the last turn. The Stewards reviewed both claims but took no action, allowing the original order of finish to stand
