OUR SECOND SLEW moved up three and four wide to become a factor around the turn, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and drove clear. PERFECT SONG pressed the pace just off rail, made a clear lead into the stretch but missed in a strong effort. PAGAN CAT passed tired ones along the inside. WILD PROOF prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. PRIDE OF MARY flashed brief foot on the rail. TOMAC set the pace under heavy pressure, had little left for the drive. SIGNALS CHOICE had early speed along the inside, tired. PUNK ROBINSON showed little, three wide.
