SUMMERLAND pressured the pace from the inside, contested the rail through the turn, took over toward the eighth pole and dug in under determined encouragement to maintain. OUR HONOR pressured the pace three wide, contested the turn and dug in from the head of lane in a heated duel to get place. JAMAICAN EXPRESS set a pressured pace off the rail, dueled between horses through the turn and dug in gamely before grudgingly ceding place the final strides. GAARA chased the pace toward mid track, saved ground through the turn, eased out in the upper stretch and finished evenly. FIRST DEGREE chased the pace about the four path, angled out leaving the three sixteenths pole and finished evenly. KIDS' COLLEGE FUND, shuffled back on the chute, gave close early chase toward the outside but had no response in the stretch. BRAHMS LULLABY saved ground nearing the turn. ARKLOW CAT chased the early pace from the outside, came through the turn six wide then weakened in the stretch.
