CASEY DOON duled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose up the backstretch, opened a clear margin entering the second turn, remained well clear entering the drive and proved much the best while kept to task. NASTRO AZZURRO unhurried early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded but could not reach the winner. OCTAVIO (CHI) allowed to settle early, advanced inside, responded to pressure entering the drive and finished well. VILLAGE BAND could only pass tired ones. GUSTIAMO went evenly. SLAM DOWN chased the early pace outside and tired. EXECUTIVE SHANE forced the early pace and tired. DIAMOND ACCOUNT was finished early.
