Footnotes

PIANNA rated a short lead inside, came under pressure nearing the quarter pole, was driven into the stretch and widened with moderate hand urging. DINO RIDER stalked the pace two deep, pressured the winner nearing the quarter pole, couldn't match strides with that one leaving the final turn but duelled gamely to preserve place. LETMEGETMYBROOM, off the pace inside, started a drive leaving the three eighths pole, improved her position through the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. GHOSTLY GIN VISION rated close to the early pace toward mid track, bid approaching the quarter pole, saved some ground through the turn then weakened in the stretch. C B ROCKS was not a factor. LADEPUTAUT rated close at the winners' heels the opening turn, stayed in range off the rail through the backstretch but faded toward the final turn. BACK DOOR CUT rated off the pace two deep, took aim past the seven sixteenths pole then faded nearing the final turn.
