MYSTERIOUS NUMBERS quickly took over a short lead inside, rated the pace to the quarter pole, was pressured from the three sixteenths, lost some ground entering the stretch but dug in from there to widen under steady handling. MONSTER DINNER chased the pace from the inside, stuck to the rail rounding the turn and dug in for a stretch long duel for place. MAMA MIA DIAMOND stalked the winner two deep, lost ground leaving the turn and was outfinished in a stretch long duel for place. ELLIES TATTLE TALE chased the pace from the outside, rounded the turn five wide and finished evenly. INTREPID WARRIOR chased the early pace about the three path, drifted out leaving the turn and leveled off down the lane. UP IN REALITY chased the pace from the inside then flattened stride through the lane. TRUE GHOSTLY gave chase off the rail and weakened leaving the turn. LITTLE LARRY, loose in the post parade, was not a factor.
