Footnotes

BLUEMONT'S PRIZE alternated on the lead from the rail, drew off around the turn, lug out under left handed urging in mid stretch while clear and prevailed. DR. B. OZ sluggish at the start, advanced four wide, angled to the rail on the turn, closed with a rush through the stretch. GRACEFUL GALE broke awkwardly, moved up just off the rail, finished well. MISS SHARONDIPITY alternated for the lead along the inside, lacked a closing bid. RACE ON BIRDCEE bore out and bumped with VERMONT GILAN at the start, stalked four wide, finished willingly. STAR CLUSTER forced the issue from the rail, lacked a late response. DOLLYS AFFAIR prompted the pace three wide, tired. CRIBBING SAMMI bumped at the start, angled to the rail down the backstretch but was no factor. VERMONT GILAN bumped then in tight at the start, made little impact three wide.
