PERFECTITUDE rated a short lead inside, came under pressure at the quarter pole, was driven approaching the top of the stretch and under steady handling to the wire. BOLD PHIL rated close about the three path, made his bid at the three eighths pole and was along late for place outside. MO'S BRO rated close inside, bid at the rail leaving the five sixteenths pole, leveled out in the drive and outfinished late for place. EVERY MOVE U MAKE stalked the pace off the rail, challenged the winner from the quarter pole and gave chase through the final turn before leveling off. ENGLISH ALPHABET settled back inside, bid at the quarter pole and mildly improved in the stretch. PUNK ROBINSON settled back off the rail, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole then weakened in the stretch.
