JOHAR'S BIG CHARM settled back inside, bid near the rail past the five sixteenths pole, eased around the tiring pacesetter into the stretch, dueled to the front past the sixteenth pole and dug in under a determined rider to prevail. SHINE BOX settled off the pace inside, moved to contention three wide approaching the five sixteenths pole, took over just past the pole, drew clear on the final turn, drifted outward entering the stretch, was caught approaching the wire but dug in gamely to remain a close factor. STONE DANCER, well back off the rail, improved his position rounding the final turn but flattened stride down the lane. I'TS JUST ABOUT ME rated the early pace inside, came under pressure toward the five sixteenths pole, yielded control past the pole then gave way in the stretch. PLEASANT GALLOP raced well back then passed some tiring rivals. GALLANT GUY passed some tired rivals, was unsaddled on the turn, appeared sore and vanned off. HAWKSBURY CROSSING stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole then gave way on the final turn. OUR LONGFELLOW was no factor inside after a half mile.
