Footnotes

EVENING CONCERTO rated just off the pace about the three path, inched to contention leaving the half mile pole, dueled to the front two deep into the final turn, drew clear midstretch and held on well. SEEKING THE POINT rated clear inside, came under pressure toward the three eighths pole, contested the edge to the final turn, was caught past the quarter pole and dropped back into the lane but continued a close factor to the end. BLACK TIE ONLY settled close off the rail, gave chase toward the three eighths pole, saved ground through the final turn, eased off the rail in the upper stretch then leveled off late. GANGA, off the pace two deep, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole but proved empty down the lane. BEAU AMERICAN settled off the pace inside, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then weakened through the lane. LITTLE FEAT settled off the early pace outside and was through after a half mile.
