PEACEFUL PLACE was allowed to settle early while six wide on the backstretch, made a five wide move on the far turn, then edged away late to prove best under a drive. TOUR HOSTESS pressed the early pace and made a three wide bid on the far turn, but was outfinished late. FRUITS was settled back early, came five wide into the stretch to rally well getting the show award in the final jump. QUOIT QUICK was allowed to settle early, came four wide into the stretch to finish well while being outfinished for the show. SKORCH TWO passed the tiring rivals. DOLLY'S WAGER set a pressured pace early and gave way. SARDIS chased the early pace and weakened. BOONE'S GOLD chased the early pace and tired.
