Footnotes

PAPERS TO PROVE IT broke alertly to set the pace, drew off down the backstretch, held clear on the turn then was kept to strong urging through the stretch to prevail. FIRST AND BAY prompted the pace three wide, made his bid around the turn and was steadily gaining in the drive. QUIET TRIP off the pace saving ground, rallied four wide on the turn and finished willingly through the lane. CALM AND COLLECTED three wide along the backstretch, began to advance five wide around the turn and finished strongly at the end. MR. BOURBON STREET forced the pace three and four wide, lacked the needed late rally. READ MY TALE pressed the issue just off the rail, fell back on the turn and had faded through the stretch. PUMA'S BLUFF had only brief speed on the rail.
