PERFECT CREVASSE moved up three wide to engaged the pace setting SPEEDY TUXEDO down the backstretch, drew off around the turn then was all out to last at the end. SINGIN THE BLUES settled off the leaders three and four wide, began to pick up rivals on the turn then closed with a rush through the lane. ETCHED IN STONE off a step slow then bumped and squeezed back at the start, advanced four and five wide and finished well. PANTASTIC forced out and bumped with ETCHED IN STONE at the start, stalked the leaders four wide, dropped to the rail on the turn then had no late bid. SPEEDY TUXEDO made a slim lead just off the rail along the backstretch, fell back around the turn. VANDAS ANGEL bumped at the start, was no factor from the inside. ZION'S TREASURE bore out at the start, quickly moved up to set the pace, stopped after a half.
