MISS FANTASTIC in good position pressing the pace, was set down for the drive, gained the lead in late stretch and drove clear. RIGHT REWARD set the pace while under pressure, opened a clear lead on the turn, dug in through the stretch but weakened the last sixteenth. GOVERNMENT BAILOUT stalked the leaders from the inside, rallied around the turn but failed to sustain her bid. DANCINGINTHECITY prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. NICTATE within striking distance while three wide, failed to respond when asked in the lane. RUGGED CROSS well placed on the rail, lacked a closing bid. I'LL FIND YOU off step slow then in tight at the start, was no factor, three and four wide. RUM CITY forced the pace four wide, tired. CRUSADER'S ANGEL a pace factor five and six wide, lacked a late bid.
