PHONE JAZZ moved up just off the rail, angled out for the drive, caught STACY'S DOUBLE DEE in late stretch and drove clear. STACY'S DOUBLE DEE set the pace off the rail under strong pressure, moved clear on the turn, led until late stretch then was out finished. RHEMA advanced four wide, failed to sustain her bid. SUPER T pressed the issue three wide, lacked a late response. PRIZED AFFAIR made a run along the rail around the turn, came up empty in the drive. DENALI BULLETTE three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. SHEZOUTAHERE prompted the pace three and four wide, fell back around the turn. MEMORIAL DRIVE five wide around the first turn, was four wide along the backstretch trying to stay close but tired. NO MORE CHANCES was used up after a half, four and five wide.
