Footnotes

SASSY TEMPO tracked the leaders three deep, drew off in the stretch. WHOISVENDELADENTE broke sharply and opened up a clear margin on the first turn, maintained that advantage to the stretch, labored in the final furlong but had enough in reserve to hold the place. FEELIN LUCK TODAY always close up, weakened in the stretch drive. SO SHE SAID had no speed, swung wide into the stretch, managed a mild bid. STAINLESS STEEL always in the middle of the pack, failed to respond. MELEIUM was unhurried early, showed little interest. BEAUTIFUL INGENUIE lagged far back, never reached contention. SLEWSPREE offered little in a lackluster outing. LUCY'S CAT broke in air, rushed to contention while very rank, stopped badly on the backstretch and was eased.
