Footnotes

MARK ON THE RUN settled close to the early pace inside, eased out at the half mile pole, bid from the three eighths, contested at a disadvantage two deep rounding the final turn but dug in through the lane to earn the nod the final strides. ROUGH TIME rated a slim lead inside, contested the edge rounding the final turn, held the advantage under a hard stretch drive but missed the nod the closing strides. OMEGA SUPREME settled back toward the outside, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, entered the stretch four wide and leveled off from there. SWAGGABOY, well back toward mid track, saved ground with a bid approaching the quarter pole, eased to the six path into the lane then lugged inward while leveling off. IT'S GOODTOBE DUKE settled off the pace toward mid track, gave chase from the half mile pole but lacked a significant response rounding the final turn. ROLL THAT WAY, well off the pace inside, was blocked at the heels of the waning Tumultuous nearing the five sixteenths pole and made no further effort. ARCH AVENTURE stalked the early pace three wide, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole, was shuffled back from between horses nearing the quarter pole and gave way on the turn. TUMULTUOUS stalked the early pace two deep but gave way after a half mile.
