**Footnotes**

REGALATINA rated a clear lead inside, was prompted from the five sixteenths pole, came under a drive toward the end of the final turn, widened into the stretch and steadily encouraged through the lane. ESSAY, reluctant to load, settled off the pace off the rail, bid nearing the three eighths pole, eased out entering the stretch and duelled for place. SKYLAR GOT EVEN stalked the pace three wide, gave chase from the half mile pole then outfinished in the duel for place. DANCE TICKET flipped in the paddock, settled back toward mid track, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn about the three path and finished evenly. HAVENS TESTAMONY stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole and stayed in range through the final turn before leveling off down the lane. FLYING TIGERIST settled back about the three path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole and had little left in the lane. ZIPPY CURVES was unprepared and came away awkwardly, gave chase about the four path the opening turn then faded saving ground approaching the final turn. GRACE OF SERENITY, well back off the rail, lost ground on the final turn. GOBLINS ANNAJIG was no factor outside. IN SHAM BULS stalked the early pace off the rail then faded after three eighths.
