TRUCKEE WHISP pressed the issue three wide, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then drew off. EXCLUSIVE LEADER bore in and bumped with PERNAMBUCO after the start, set the balance of the pace then was all out to hold second. MAJOR DANGER off slow, saved ground, rallied five wide around the turn, closed with a rush through the lane. TERMSOFENGAGEMENT advanced three wide, finished strongly. I'M A SLUGGER made a run four wide around the turn but failed to sustain his bid. PERNAMBUCO bumped just after the start, stalked the leaders four wide, failed to respond. WAY TO DOUGH BOY forced the issue three wide, lacked the needed rally. GATEWAY MOON saved ground, rallied around the turn, lacked a closing bid. BAY BUTTON BILL prompted the pace along the rail, faded through the stretch. DREAMY RUN flashed brief foot on the rail.
