Footnotes

LIMITMENOT, edgy in the gate, stalked the pace off the rail, took aim leaving the quarter pole, dug in for the lead midstretch, edged clear under a hardy drive but appeared to be sore upon return. COPPER RIVER QUEST, four wide early, settled back about the four path, made her bid near the quarter pole and closed steadily to get place at the wire. SUCCULENT SCORE rated the pace inside, came under pressure toward the quarter pole, yielded to the winner in midstretch, was outfinished for place at the wire and just lasted for show. I FOUND SWEETIEPIE settled off the pace inside, bid near the rail at the quarter pole, eased outward through the lane then leveled off toward the wire. HAWAIIAN PRINCESS saved ground racing well back. JEAN'S DREAM moved to even terms three wide at the seven sixteenths pole, stalked the pace to the quarter pole, gave chase from there though faded rounding the final turn. MIA GRACIE showed no speed off the rail. SUADELA was not a factor.
