LOOK TO HEAVEN vied for the early lead and made a three wide bid at the quarter pole, drew off to prove much the best while being ridden out. PATTY CAKES was rated early, came four wide into the stretch, no match for the winner, held place. CHEVAUX was allowed to settle early, came five wide into the stretch, but lacked the needed bid. HOITY TOITY had a belated rally on the inside. BELLE ANGEL vied for the lead on the inside, had to steady past the quarter pole, weakened. QUITE AN EVENING was bumped at the start, lacked a rally. ANGEL PUNCH failed to menace. DON'T CALL ME BABY dropped back. POPPINS POPPER was not a factor. SPIRITED MARKET stopped. After a stewards inquiry and jockeys' objection the winner was disqualified and placed fifth for apparent interference past the quarter pole.
