CATTAIL RUN pressed the pace three wide, made a clear lead on the turn, prevailed under strong urging. SAY WHAT YOU WANT advanced three and four wide, finished well. VALIANT RACHAEL moved up four and five wide, finished strongly through the lane. VIVETTE saved ground, came three wide around the turn, lacked a late response. ERA GRAND with the leaders three wide, lacked the needed rally. BREADMAN'S HONEY bumped then in tight at the start, was four and five wide, lacked a late bid. SOFT DANCER flashed brief foot along the inside. SOFT PETALS bore out and bumped with BREADMAN'S HONEY at the start then was no factor on the rail. ROSA MORENA set the pace just off the rail, gave way around the turn.
