EYES FOR GOLD chased the pace toward mid track, improved five wide on the turn and dueled to the lead the final yards. I'M ALL IRISH, hustled along with a brief early lead, continued to give chase throughout, was outfinished for the win and just lasted in place. JOY TRAIN showed no early speed well back and outside, came through the turn widest, was under a drive entering the stretch, angled to the rail nearing the wire and just missed place. PRECIOUS HECKLE settled on the front end inside, was asked for more near the quarter pole then outfinished in late yards. SHES UNFORGETTABLE showed no speed off the rail, angled outward on the turn and finished evenly. HEY U chased the pace four wide then leveled off from the quarter pole. CHROME COINS chased the pace three wide then faded through the turn. RUNABILITY chased the pace inside then faded on the turn. PINK OCTOBER was not a factor.
