Footnotes

THE VIN MAN tardy at the start, rushed to the lead dropping to the rail, prevailed while kept to urging. SPECIAL UNION broke in a tangle, stalked the pace from the inside and was second best late. ROOSTER PIE sluggish at the start, rallied four wide around the turn, finished willingly. JAZZ SEEKER moved up three and four wide, failed to sustain his bid. ON ONE NOD prompted the issue three wide, lacked a closing bid. BRIGADER pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked the needed rally. SWEET ALLEN had early speed, steadily fell back. GOLD TEXAN flashed brief foot, four wide. MAKE A WESH off a step slow, showed little three wide.
