Footnotes

SLAMENTINE gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off around the turn, widened through the stretch under urging. SAINT ANTHONY saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well to be second best. JOE'S LAD bore out and bumped with GLOBAL ICON at the start, pressed the pace from the rail but was no match for the winner in the drive. JOE THE PLUMBER lugged out after the start, bumped with WILD AGAIN SOUL, prompted the pace but lacked a late response. EIGHT GOLD MEDALS forced the pace three wide, lacked a closing bid. RED LIGHT stalked the leaders three and four wide, lacked the needed late rally. GLOBAL ICON bumped then in tight at the start, never threatened three wide. ODDBALL lugged in after the start, bumped with WILD AGAIN SOUL, was five and six wide while failing to menace. WILD AGAIN SOUL bumped then squeezed back after the start, was no factor four and five wide. GOLD N SILVER F F saved ground to no avail.
