Footnotes

MR. FIUME moved clear to save ground nearing the five eighths pole, rated the pace to the quarter pole, came under pressure from that point and widened under with stretch handling. CLEAR RECEPTION, well back outside, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and dug in through the stretch to just get up for place. MR. GUNNER, off the early pace inside, eased toward mid track leaving the first turn, bid from the three eighths pole, saved ground into the final turn, raced evenly in the number two spot through the lane but was caught leveling off toward the wire. CONTINETTA, well back from the early pace off the rail, raced widest into the backstretch, bid leaving the three eighths pole and passed tiring rivals. SALTY MUSIC, off the pace inside, gave chase from the half mile pole but showed little response through the backstretch. RUBEN TIPSTER settled just off the early pace about the four path, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole then weakened saving ground on the final turn. MOUNTAINEER MANIAC raced well off the pace toward the outside. BURLMAN was no factor saving ground. LITCHFIELD kept close to the pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded rounding the final turn. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the rider of the second place finisher, lodged by the rider of Salty Music, though found no cause to make a change.
