**Footnotes**

SHES CHARISMATIC settled well off the pace inside, eased out with a bid from the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn in the four path and dug in at the head of the lane to get up the final strides. RUGGED CROSS rated just off the pace about the four path, bid at the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead midway on the final turn, dug in with the advantage through the lane but was outfinished in late strides. STAINED GLASS rated a clear lead inside, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole, caught mid turn then weakened the final sixteenth. LINDA'S CANDY rated just off the pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then faded through the final turn. COW TOWN KID settled well off the pace in the three and four paths, made a mild outside bid from the three eighths pole then leveled off saving ground on the final turn. MY REWARD rated just off the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then faded saving ground on the final turn. FFFABULOUSLY FLEET, well off the pace toward mid track, was through after a half mile. SATIN ROSE raced well back and showed no response.
