Footnotes

GIANABLUE took some early pressure while setting a rated pace towards the rail, moved clear into the second turn, repelled a challenge from GENERAL RUTLEDGE nearing the quarter pole then drew away while mainly hand ridden. GENERAL RUTLEDGE gained a stalking position along the rail through the opening quarter mile, eased out after a half mile, moved two wide to briefly threaten the winner into the far turn, was put to a strong drive soon after, failed to keep pace but was clearly second best. BEE REGAL, taken to rate early, angled out five wide nearing the backstretch, dropped in making progress leaving the three eighths pole, chased the winner around the final turn, eased out entering the stretch but failed to generate a solid closing kick. WILD PEAK was steadied between rivals around the first turn, eased out three wide to chase, raced forwardly to the quarter pole then faded. REAL QUIET TIME was rated back to last, lost ground four wide from the half mile marker, made a mild run leaving the far turn then flattened out. HABOUR SHARK was rated back along the rail nearing the stretch the first time, chased two wide down the backstretch and faded. MOLINARO DEPARTURE failed to menace. FORT DIX, three wide disputing the early pace, stopped after a half mile and was eased through the drive.
