Footnotes

CAN'T RUN A JUMP led early, steadied into the first turn, angled three wide leaving the five-eighths pole, advanced four wide around the far turn, rallied outside and was up in deep stretch. I'VEGOTADATE was bumped just after the start, settled off the pace while racing four wide around the first turn, circled five wide around the far turn, rallied widest and was up for the place in the final strides. GLENYATTA stalked the pace two wide, bid three deep entering the far turn, took the lead leaving the quarter pole, set the pace well off the rail around that bend and led until deep stretch. MY GIRL JULES lacked speed along the rail, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied belatedly. N STAR dueled three wide through the opening half and faded around the far turn. GRUMPSHERGRANNY dueled inside of N STAR while racing in the two path and gave way nearing the far turn. AFFAIR ARRANGEMENT raced along the rail and failed to menace. TOR was bumped just after the start, saved ground early, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened.
