QUEEN'O'DABALL settled back toward the inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased out rounding the final turn, took over three wide approaching the top of the lane, dueled clear in the upper stretch and held well under steady handling. BY GOLLY MOLLY settled off the pace in the three and four paths, bid past the three eighths pole, improved four wide on the final turn, dueled for place in the upper stretch then leveled off toward the wire. THREE PEARLS stalked the pace off the rail, bid approaching the five sixteenths pole, took the lead nearing the quarter, contested the edge most of the final turn but was caught toward the top of the lane and leveled off the last sixteenth. LADY SNABE, well back inside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole then leveled out down the lane. NODEBTDANNY raced well back off the rail, bid mildly approaching the five sixteenths pole but showed little further. HIDEHETHEBLACKGOLD rated a clear lead inside, was pressured nearing the five sixteenths pole, caught toward the quarter then weakened nearest the rail approaching the head of the lane. FLASHY BERTIE rated off the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then faded toward the final turn.
