COWGIRLS DON'T CRY broke well from the outside to duel for the early lead, shook loose entering the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. TWO COLUMBUS allowed to settle early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded when asked and was getting to the winner late. CULPEPER MOON outrun early, circled rivals on the second turn, responded and closed with a rush. DICEY GIRL forced the early pace from between foes but had nothing left. STORY OF A LION dueled with the winner for the early lead and tired. SWEETAMYGEE chased the pace from the inside and tired.
