Footnotes

RACE FOR DOUGH gave chase toward mid track, rounded the turn about the four path and dug in from the head of the lane to earn the edge in the final strides. LUV WINS, brushed lightly at the start, gave chase off the rail, dug in to take a slim lead nearing the sixteenth pole, lugged inward past the pole and was outfinished the final strides. DOLLY SODS, shut off at the start, gave chase toward the outside through the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, eased out entering the stretch, finished well and was gaining on the runner-up. SKIP THE LIMIT chased the pace from the inside, lost momentum near the rail approaching the head of the lane, eased to the two path leaving the turn but leveled off the final sixteenth. MINSTREL NOTES broke in making light contact with Luv Wins, hustled to the front to rate the pace inside, came under pressure toward the head of the lane, was caught in the upper stretch and weakened the final sixteenth. KELYO chased the pace from the outside, rounded the turn about the four path then leveled off down the lane. MIDSUMMER LADY chased the pace off the rail then leveled out down the lane. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul lodged against the runner-up, by the rider of Skip The Limit, but took no action.
