Footnotes

STANDING POINT settled just off the pace about the three path, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, rapidly made up ground on the early leader to take over in an upper stretch duel, raced clear past the sixteenth pole and held well under steady handling. SURFING UP settled back in the three and four paths, bid approaching the five sixteenths pole and dug in to contest a stretch long duel for place. SHENANDOAH rated off the pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole but was out-finished in a stretch long duel for place. BIRD HUNTER raced clear approaching the three quarter pole to rate the pace inside, was pressured leaving the quarter, caught in an upper stretch duel and leveled off the last sixteenth. SECOND BATTALION saved ground the opening turn, settled back outside leaving the turn, started a bid while angling in nearing the five sixteenths pole, eased back out entering the stretch but showed little further. PARKER HOLLOW ROAD rounded the first turn about the four path, dropped back leaving the turn and was not a factor. SO SAYS SIMON stalked the early pace off the rail, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole then faded toward the final turn.
