Footnotes

BIG JIMMY J. quickly established control while saving ground into the first turn, rated the pace inside to the top of the lane, came under a drive from that point and dueled gamely to deter the runner-up to the wire. ROCK PICKER stalked the pace off the rail, was put to a drive from the three eighths pole and held aim through the lane; though needed more. AISLE BE, unhurried early, improved position outside through the backstretch, had aim three wide at the head of the stretch and finished evenly at the girth of the runner-up. ROYAL LOUIE, well back and off the rail, eased out to make a bid leaving the quarter pole and finished evenly. TYRAE was kept close to the early going about the three path but showed no response on the final turn. HIDDEN SOURCE and COPPER RIVER were not factors. PASSING LANE stumbled at the break, settled off the pace inside then bid mildly at the rail on the final turn. INCLUDE THE MONEY rated close about the four path but faded after three eighths.
