### Footnotes

BLUE CATILLAC stalked the pace off the rail, challenged past the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the front leaving the final turn and dug in under hardy encouragement to discourage the efforts of Lady Minka. LADY MINKA rated the pace inside, was pressured leaving the five sixteenths pole, caught entering the lane, dug in gamely leaving the eighth pole but reluctantly ceded the final sixteenth. LADY SNABE, well off the pace off the rail, bid past the three eighths pole, eased to the three path rounding the far turn, dug in at the head of the lane but leveled off the final sixteenth. TIZ MAGNIFIQUE came away awkwardly and bobbed a stride out, kept just off the pace off the rail, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. KAREN'S RAG DOLL, well back off the rail, made a mild bid rounding the final turn. SUBTLE DEMEANOR raced well back toward the outside and lost more ground on the final turn.
