### Footnotes

A LISTER had speed from the start, went up to battle for the lead between horses leaving the first turn, set a pressured pace and matched strides with LITTLE MARIE into the stretch then dug in under energetic handling and drew away late. LITTLE MARIE was hung four wide around the first turn, went up to match strides for the lead nearing the half mile pole, dueled into the stretch then was no match for the winner but finished clear for second. STEALING MONEY went evenly. SHE SURE IS offered a mild bid on the backstretch then leveled off. ROYAL BRIDGE was no threat. THISCOULDBETRICKY had speed for a half along the rail then weakened. BEER TEARS had brief speed. TEXAS BABY BIRD set the early pace, stopped on the second turn and was vanned off after crossing the wire.
