SEA REP RUN angled in approaching the first turn, took a slim lead at the thirteen sixteenths pole, rated the pace to the three eighths, was pressured from that point and widened under steady stretch handling. MACHO STYLE rated off the pace inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, closed the gap to the five sixteenths pole, could make no further gain and leveled off down the lane. SWEET REP, well back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved off the rail rounding the final turn, reached third midstretch and leveled off from there. FRANK GALL, bumped off stride soon after the break, was pinched back into the first turn, settled well off the pace about the three path, gave chase from the half mile pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. NOT FOR GRANTED, pinched back into the opening turn, raced well off the pace toward mid track and showed no response through the backstretch. ANNA'S BOY drew clear into the first turn to briefly show the way, stayed with the pace from the thirteen sixteenths pole, gave chase from the half mile pole then faded rounding the final turn. YATES' COWBOYCARSON raced well back off the rail. GHOSTLY MONEY broke in making sharp contact with Frank Gall then raced well back off the rail. BELTWAY BANDIT, off the pace about the three path, gave way after a half mile. The stewards reviewed claims of foul against the rider of the winner, lodged by the riders of Not For Granted and Frank Gall, and disqualified the former to fifth place for angling across the path of the latter two into the first turn.
