Footnotes

BEGRIFF up close around the first turn, rated three wide off the leaders down the backstretch, rallied around the turn to become prominent, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and drove clear. JOYFUL KISS pressed the issue from the rail, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch, led until the sixteenth pole, could not hold off the winner while clearly second best. PARKER'SGOLDENCAT set the pace from the rail, dug in around the turn, weakened through the stretch. MICKEYTHEPREACHER made a run four wide along the backstretch, began to drop back on the turn and had little left for the drive. FORBES off the pace three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. LIL MARVIN stalked the leaders four wide, drifted eight wide into the stretch and tired noticeably in the drive. PRAIRIE BOY made little impact from the rail. RUGBYSROLLINGSTONE had brief foot along the inside.
