QUAIL HOLLOW broke outward bumping ADRIANA'S BOY at the start, was allowed to settle, rallied three wide down the backstretch to make the lead near the quarter pole, set the balance of the pace and drew clear under strong handling. LEOBUSTER unhurried early, picked up ground steadily outside rivals on the second turn, swung a bit wide entering the stretch then rallied determinedly and finished clear for second. OUR HAE made the lead soon after the start, set the pace along the rail until the quarter pole then finished with good courage along the rail in a dead heat for third. DECOLATOR with the second flight into the stretch, rallied three wide and finished in a dead heat for third. SEA OF LIQUIDITY pressed the pace two and three wide and finished with good courage between horses. SERGEANT SAXTON well placed, failed to offer a closing response. FIRST AND BAY was no factor. KILMOGANNY trailed. ADRIANA'S BOY was bumped at the trailed, prompted the early pace tow wide then stopped.
